



LEARNING GROUPS

A learning group is a group of students and staff who remain together throughout the school quarter, semester or year. These groups are able to work and play together while minimizing physical contact. Students and staff not in the same group or "cohort" will be expected to maintain physical distancing.

Elementary

Maximum 60 students and staff per cohort.

Four of SD85 Elementary Schools have a population of less than 60. They will be considered one cohort.

Three of SD85 Elementary Schools have a population of over 60. These schools will have two or more learning cohorts.



Secondary

Maximum 120 students and staff per cohort.

One of SD85 Secondary Schools has a population of less than 120. They will be considered one cohort.

Two of SD85 Secondary Schools have a population of over 120. These schools will have two or more learning cohorts.

Social distancing, increased cleaning protocols, and alternative entrances will be implemented.
