



WORKSITE PROTOCOLS

Under guidance from the provincial government, the Provincial Health Officer, the BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC) and our local health authority, SD85 schools have strict health and safety measures to ensure the safety of our staff and students.

Health Checks

Staff

Upon arrival staff must sign in, complete daily personal health check, and sanitize their hands.

Staff will then proceed to designated learning cohort area.

Staff will sign out and sanitize when leaving the building as well.



Visitors to Schools

Additional Measures

All visitors, including parents will need to schedule in advance entry to school. Visitors are expected to hand wash / sanitize, social distance, complete a health check, and provide contact tracing information.

Cleaning Protocols

Additional Custodial Coverage

Day custodians will rotate through the school on an ongoing basis ensuring all touch points are disinfected continually.

Evening Custodians will perform regular cleaning duties as well as continued disinfecting.

Classrooms will have non-essential items removed from the classroom to allow for more thorough cleaning of surfaces.
